



Lake County Centralized Eligibility List Subsidized Program Descriptions

Parents may need to meet eligibility requirements to each program.

ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT PROGRAM (APP)

These programs are funded with state and federal funds and offer a wide range of child care arrangements for parents, including centers, family child care homes and license-exempt providers. Children served in these programs range in age from birth through age twelve. (Income and need requirements apply.)

EARLY HEAD START

These programs operate full or half day centers for children ages birth to 3 years old. These programs offer comprehensive education, health, and social services resources for the whole family. Many programs are bi-lingual.

FAMILY CHILD CARE NETWORKS (NET)

These programs are administered by the APP program and provide subsidized child care within family child care settings. These programs provide an educational component that is developmentally, culturally, and linguistically appropriate for the children served. These programs also provide meals and snacks to children. (Income and need requirements apply.)

GENERAL CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT

These programs operate state and federally funded centers. These programs provide child development services for children from birth through age twelve. These programs provide an educational component that is developmentally, culturally, and linguistically appropriate for the children served. These programs also provide meals and snacks to children, parent education, and referrals to health and social services for families and staff development opportunities to employees. Programs are offering full day services. (Income and need requirements apply.)

LCOE AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS

LCOE Kid Connection Programs are open every day after school until 6:00 PM and also on most days when school is not in session from 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM. (Income and need requirements apply).

LCOE ASES PROGRAMS

These programs will be open every day after school until 6:00 PM only on the days that school is in session. The fee for this program is \$75.00 per child per month with no eligibility requirements. Serving children five to eleven years old.

Both Kid Connection and ASES Programs are working in collaboration with your child's school to provide you and your children with safe, dependable, academic, and high quality programs. Under the supervision of a caring staff these programs provide: Homework support, enrichment and recreation activities, crafts, games, team building, as well as prevention activities and guest speakers.

STATE PRESCHOOLS

State preschools are dedicated to offering programs that focus on early literacy skills, to prepare your child for Kindergarten. State preschools provide the perfect balance of learning and play in a safe, nurturing environment. Children in preschools are inspired to explore, experience and make valuable learning connections with their world. These programs serve children ages three to five years old. (Income eligibility requirements apply).
